NOW Life Group Leaders agree to:

- Avoid viewing pornography (Matthew 5:28)
- Stay away from excessive alcohol and drug use. (Ephesians 5:18, Galatians 5:19-21)
- Use their speech to uplift and edify those around them. (Matthew 15:11, Ephesians 4:29, Titus 2:7-8)
- Use social media responsibly (Matthew 18:6, Hewbrews 13:18)

Group Communication Tips

Use a group communication app

The best way to communicate with everyone in your group is by communicating with everyone at the same time! There are several different apps available, just find the one that works best for your group! Suggestions: GroupMe, Slack, Facebook group, etc.

Use Plans with Friends

Keep your group communicating throughout the week by doing Bible Plans together in the YouVersion Bible App! This is a great way to grow and learn together!

Fill your Life Group

Start with your friends at church

Who do you connect with? Ask the people you attend with or serve with.

Look at your neighborhood

Your Life Group doesn't have to consist of people solely from our church. Are there people you live around who need healthy relationships?

Connect extra-curricular activities

Invite the parents of your kids' friends from sports and other activities. Are you in any activities? Invite them too!

Don't forget social media

You may be forgetting about someone who's looking for a group just like yours. And you never know who is searching for the community your group can provide. Advertise your group on your social media platforms.

Join the Growth Track Team

Every month, our Growth Track Team helps connect people to their spiritual next step, whether it's someone who has just raised their hand to accept Christ, someone ready to start serving, or someone looking for a Life Group. Not only will you get to help answer questions and invest in people spiritually, but you can also use the opportunity to invite people to your Life Group.

A Few Best Practices

Maintain a vibrant connection with Christ!

The best way to lead others is allowing the Holy Spirit of God to lead you; the deeper your connection with Christ, the stronger your connection and leadership with the people in your group.

Create transparent relationships!

Relationship is the foundation for great leadership. When we're transparent with people, we increase the ability to speak into their lives.

Share your vision and expectations

Your vision reminds people that their Life Group isn't a program; it's a lifestyle that will have a significant impact on their lives. In addition, what commitment do you desire from your group?

Have a plan

Always be aware of the direction of your group and lead them according to God's leading in you. In addition, take an adequate amount of time before meetings to prepare, pray, etc.

Never cancel your group

Even if you know no one will be at group, don't "cancel." This devalues the importance of the group. In addition, when you're out of town, ensure someone steps up to lead.
